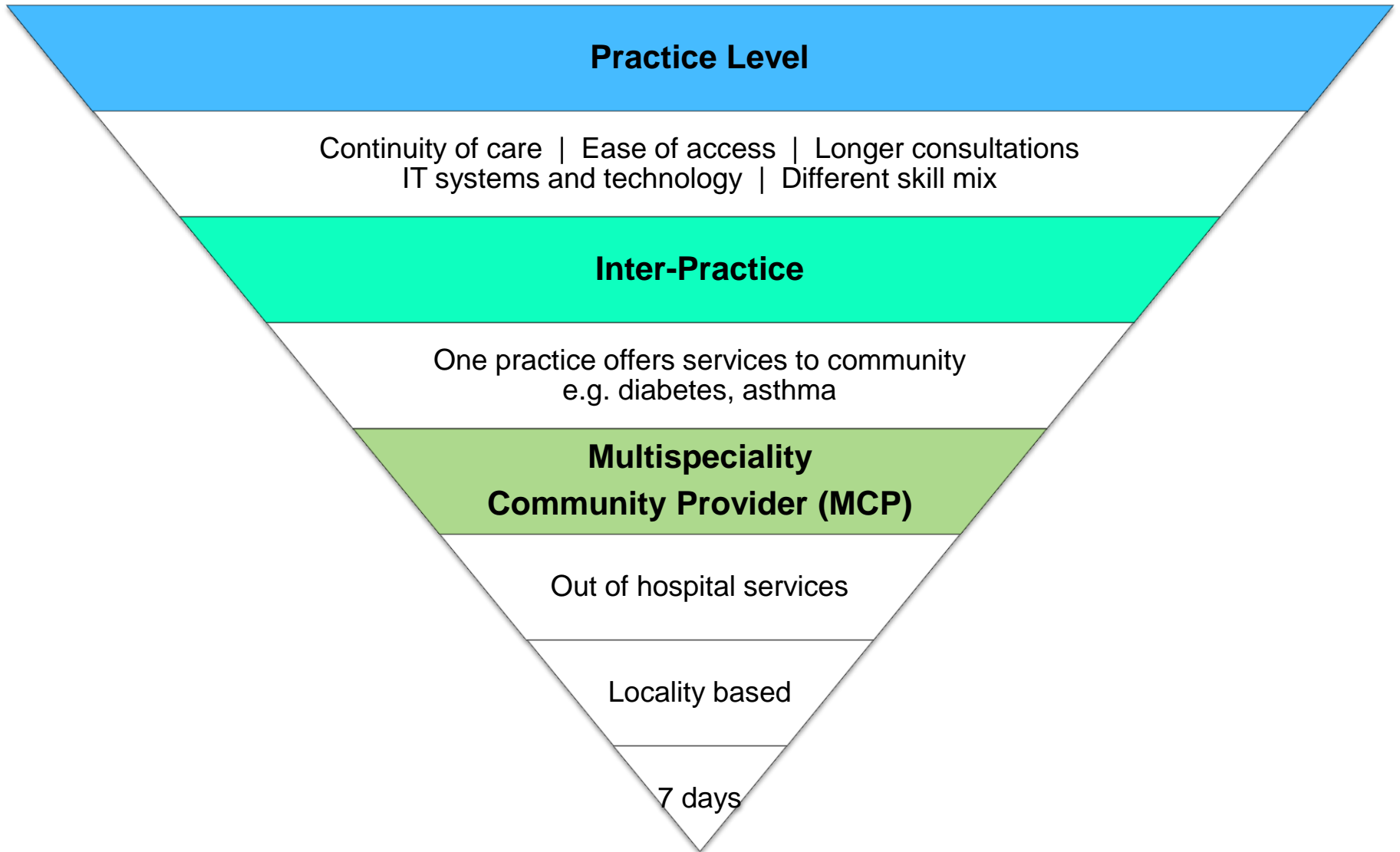
# What we know about BaNES

- **Very high standards of care and satisfaction**
  - **A growing population**
  - **An ageing population**
  - **More people with multiple long term conditions**
  - **An ageing workforce feeling under pressure**
  - **Difficult to recruit new GPs (worse elsewhere)**
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# Patients & public have told us...


- **There are variations in how easy it is to get an appointment**
  - **Support is required to navigate the system (for those inside and outside the system!)**
  - **We should improve our use of technology and allow appropriate sharing of patient records**
  - **Specific challenges for patients with mental health conditions, at end of life or needing urgent advice out of hours**
  - **Not sure of the need for 7-day working**
